

## Required language certificates for applicants with German higher education entrance qualification

Which language certificate do German applicants require for which degree programme at the Leibniz University Hannover?

In the list you will find the language requirements for your desired study programme, provided that you possess a German higher education entrance qualification.

What is a higher education entrance qualification?

## **Bachelor's programmes**

Only very few undergraduate study programmes require German applicants to provide a language certificate:

English Studies as subject in the Interdisciplinary Bachelor's Degree Programme or the Bachelor's Teacher Training Course for Technical Education	English Level B2 (CEFR), own language regulations by the English department
Spanish as subject in the Interdisciplinary Bachelor's Degree Programme or the Bachelor's Teacher Training Course for Technical Education	Spanish level B1; own language regulations of the Department of Romance Languages and Literatures
IT and IP Law (LL.B.)	English B2

## Master's programmes

Some postgraduate degree programmes also require German applicants to provide a language certificate:

Atlantic Studies in History, Culture and Society	English B2 AND another subject-related foreign language B1 (preferably French and/or Spanish)
Computational Methods in Engineering	English C1
Economic Geography - Double Degree Track	English C1
Energy Technology – Double Degree	English C1, Not required but recommended: German or Finnish language skills.
Environmental Engineering – Track Ressources and Environment	English C1
Environmental Planning and Territorial Developement  – Major Territorial Development	English B2
European Legal Practice LL.M Joint Degree	German B2 AND language skills depending on the partner university. Further information on the programme website.

European Master in Landscape Architecture (EMiLA)	English B2 Applicants wishing to study in Versailles and / or Barcelona must have at least A2 proficiency level in French and / or Spanish at the time of application. Until the beginning of studies in the respective country, the required language level B1 (French) or B2 (Spanish) must be proven.
International Mechatronics	English C1 (this study programme is currently on hold)
Modern German Literature	At least one foreign language B1
North American Studies	English Level C1 (CEFR), own language regulations by the English department
Philosophy of Science	English B2
Quantum Engineering	English C1
Religion in the Public Sphere – Home Track	English B2
Religion in the Public Sphere – Double Degree Track	English C1
Special Needs Education and Rehabilitation Sciences	English B1
Sports Science	English B2
Water Resources and Environmental Management	English C1
